

NSP Refund Policy for Dues and Course Fees – updated September 2023

The National Ski Patrol acknowledges that on occasion there is a need to refund membership dues or course fees. These refunds will be considered provided they meet the following conditions.

Membership dues are refundable under either of the following conditions:

- The member has an overpayment of dues, e.g., due to duplicate payment by both member and patrol; or
- The member decides against joining NSP; requests the refund by sending an email to memberrecords@nsp.org within two weeks of joining; and has not received any benefit of membership (e.g., purchasing items from the NSP catalog, purchasing pro deals, or participation in any NSP event or program).

If the National office is collecting Division and Region dues, a refund of dues requires approval by the Member Services Director.

Education Course Fees are refundable under the following conditions:

- The refund request is emailed by the IOR to the NSP Education Director (education@nsp.org) before the start of the second class session and prior to the start of any other NSP course.
- The request must be approved by the NSP Education Director.
- If the student has started any online module, refunds will not be approved.
- Refund requests for OFC face-to-face courses or OEC Modified Challenge must be received prior to the day of the course event.
- Refund requests for students that have enrolled in the wrong OEC/OFC course by mistake, must be sent within 60 days of enrollment.
